The Department of Human Genetics at the University aims to gain a detailed understanding of Mendelian inherited diseases, rare intractable diseases and acquired diseases caused by somatic mutations, and to develop the mechanisms of pathogenesis and pathophysiology of diseases, as well as diagnostic and therapeutic methods. We also aim to develop genomic analysis methods.

We are seeking an individual who has a deep insight into genetic medicine, a broad knowledge of basic and applied medical research and who is actively involved in education throughout the entire educational process in the Faculty of Medicine and in postgraduate studies. In addition, we are looking for individuals who are familiar with the research field of genomic medicine and who can promote research with a focus on the development of new diagnostic and therapeutic methods.

Applicants who will undergo the second round of selection (interview) will be notified of the date and method of implementation. 3. Applicants will be responsible for any travel and accommodation expenses required for the second round of selection (interviews). 4. Applicants will be notified of the results of the selection process as soon as the final selection is completed. 5. After assuming the position, the applicant will be required to cooperate in the university's internal operations, such as the administration of entrance examinations and shared examinations. 6.
